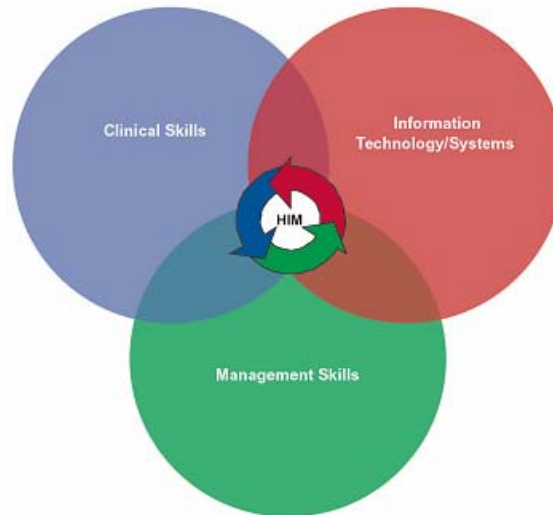


Thinking **Healthcare**?

It is the combination of medical science, business, and information technology.

HIM professionals are managers; experts in processing, analyzing and reporting information vital to the health care industry. HIM professionals are respected staff members who interact daily with the clinical staff as well as hospital administrative staff, all of whom depend on health information to perform their jobs.

HIM professionals don't just work in hospitals. They work for accounting firms, insurance companies, information systems vendors, government, pharmaceutical research companies, and others. A wide variety of employers actively recruit health information managers.

Health Information Management (HIM) and Health Information Technology (HIT) programs include science, management, information technology, finance, and law into one curriculum. Because of this unique mixture, HIM graduates can choose from a variety of work settings across various healthcare environments.
